Subject: Quality Policy and Quality Objectives of the Halal Affairs Division, CICOT

The Halal Affairs Division is the unit responsible for the inspection and certification of halal products for slaughterhouses and halal product manufacturers. Its objective is to ensure that Thailand is recognized and trusted for the quality and safety of its halal products, making them widely accepted in the global market. Therefore, in order for the Halal Affairs Division of CICOT to achieve the aforementioned objectives, the following quality policy has been established:

Halal Quality Policy, The Central Islamic Council of Thailand
"A halal certification body of Thailand that provides inspection and certification services for halal products in accordance with Islamic law, in compliance with international standards and the standards of trading partner countries, carried out by competent personnel who perform their duties with transparency, fairness, impartiality, and non-discrimination."

With the following quality objectives established in order to achieve the aforementioned quality policy:

- To conduct inspection and certification of halal products in accordance with Islamic law, in compliance with the UAE.S GSO standards and/or OIC/SMIIC standards, as well as the relevant standards, laws, regulations, and documents of trading partner countries, including the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, the Republic of Indonesia, the Republic of Türkiye, and other applicable international standards.
- To conduct inspection and provide certification to applicants with accuracy, transparency, fairness, impartiality, and non-discrimination.
- To recruit resources and develop personnel with sufficient knowledge, competence, and capability to carry out the operations effectively.
