



Announcement of The Central Islamic Committee of Thailand

Subject: Determination of Scope, Area, and Language for Halal Certification

In order for the halal certification operations of the Central Islamic Committee of Thailand to comply with GSO 2055-2, UAE.S 2055-2, OIC/SMIIC 2, and other relevant international standards, the scope, area, and language for halal certification are hereby announced as follows:

Standards for Certification:

1. Regulations of the Central Islamic Committee of Thailand on the Administration of Halal Affairs, 2015
2. Halal Certification Requirements for Slaughterhouses and Meat Processing, 2016
3. Halal Certification Requirements for the Production Process of Halal Products, 2016
4. Halal products - Part one: General Requirements for Halal Food (UAE.S GSO 2055 -1)
5. Animal Slaughtering Requirements According to Islamic Rules (UAE.S GSO 993)
6. Hygienic Regulations for Poultry Processing Abattoirs and Their Personnel (UAE.S GSO 713)
7. Hygienic Regulations for Food Plants and Their Personnel (UAE.S GSO 21)
8. Code of Hygienic Practice (GSO/CAC/RCP 58)
9. Labelling of Prepackaged Food Stuffs (UAE.S GSO 9)
10. General Requirements for Halal Food (OIC/SMIIC 1: 2019)
11. Regulation of the government of the republic of Indonesia number 42 of 2024

Scope of Certification:

1. Slaughterhouses and meat processing facilities
2. Production processes of halal products, including food, beverages, chemicals, pharmaceuticals, etc.

Area of Certification: Certification services shall be provided within Thailand, covering the defined scope of certification, regardless of size, type, or any other conditions. The Halal Affairs Division does not have a policy for multi-site certification.

Languages Used in Auditing: Thai shall be used as the primary language. If the applicant or certified party requests the use of a foreign language during the audit, the Central Islamic Committee of Thailand will consider each case individually.
